Device Financing – Multiple Promotions Setup Option

Introduction

Dealers selling devices from their own inventory with carrier Financing will have some challenges in setting up and reporting in RQ. The main issue arises when collecting a reduced amount for the device in RQ while charging full device tax. The following setup steps are suggestions only: You may want to come up with alternative measures.

The following method works well with Sprint One Up Financing. New Financing Terms are added to the Price Sheet and the phone prices are set at 0. Multi-denominational Non Stocked Products (NSPs) are created for each phone list price with specially created taxes added, which will be added automatically to each Sprint One Up sales invoice using Price Sheet Promotions.


Use the following setup steps:

Setup Overview:

- Create G/L Account
- Create Special Taxes
- Create New Price Sheet and Promotion Products in RQ
- Add new Terms to Carrier Pricing Sheet (Price Sheet)
- Set up Price Sheet Promotions


Setup Steps

1. Create G/L Account: Go to Settings | Finance | G/L Account Setup and create a new G/L account under Liabilities as Tax Collected account.




2. Create Special Taxes: Go to Settings | Finance | Tax Setup and create a new tax for every rate you currently use. Apply the tax to all locations to *List Price. Click No when asked to apply this tax to any products.

Example: If your State tax is 10%, create another tax called ST 10% State Tax. (ST = Sprint Tax)



- 3. Create New Category: Create a new category in RQ under Settings | Inventory | Product Category Setup that will contain the NSPs to adjust prices. Call it One Up Billing or something similar.
- 4. Create new Products for Price Sheet and Promotions Setup: In RQ Inventory, create the following new products:
 - a. Create NSPs to track phone list prices. These NSPs will be used in the Price Sheet Promotion Setup and should have the following criteria:
 - Description = Should represent the price denomination (see list below)
 i.e. One Up Billing \$219.99
 - Serialized = True

- Discountable = False
- Hide on Invoice = True
- Default Price = \$XXX.XX (see list below) i.e. \$219.99
- Enforced Length = 10
- Tax = Apply the newly created ST Tax(es) ONLY





Note: California dealers ONLY will also need to create a second set of NSPs called One Up Adjustments. Apply the regular state taxes to these NSPs (NOT the new taxes). They will be used later to remove the California tax only from the Sprint One Up sales.

- b. Vendor Rebate Product(s) for Price Sheet: Create a VRP for each Term type that will require the Financing option. In the example below, a 2 Year New Activation Term will be used. Best Practice is to create one and use **Right Click | Create Similar** for the rest. Use the following criteria:
 - Category = Rate Plan Rebates Commission >> One Up Financing
 - Description = 2 Year New Act w. Financing
 - Serialized = True
 - Discountable = False
 - Default Price = \$0
 - Enforced Length = 10
 - Tax = No tax applied



- c. Terms: Create a Term to match each of the VRPs created in the previous step in Inventory | Tools | Price Sheet Term Setup.
- 5. Update Price Sheet: Go to Inventory | Tools | Update Carrier Pricing Sheet to update the following information in your current price sheet:
 - a. Carrier Terms tab: Add the terms created in the previous steps and link them to the appropriate VRPs. Click **Save**. At this point, you may want to export/import your price sheet template to update the phone pricing and rebates.




- b. Retail Price and Equip Rebate tab: Enter \$0 as retail price of all devices that will be financed and add any phone rebates that apply. Check with your carrier for details.
- c. Rate Plan Rebates tab: Ensure that the rate plan commissions are filled in under the new terms next to the appropriate rate plans. These may match existing terms. Check with your carrier for details.

6. Create Price Sheet Promotion: Go to Inventory | Tools | Price Sheet Promotion Setup to create a promotion for each of the NSPs created above (currently 16 NSPs for most and 32 NSPs for California dealers only). Use the following criteria to create the promotions:


Details Tab:

- Product SKU button: Click **Product SKU** and link this promotion to one of the NSP created previously (ex.One Up Billing \$219.99)
- Unit Price = 0
- Quantity = 1
- Reduce phone price by = 0
- Name = Good practice is to use same name as NSP (i.e. One Up Billing \$219.99)
- Vendor Account = Usually the vendor account used in your price sheet
- Availability = Continual
- Locations = All locations where the Financing option is offered
- Price Sheet = Your Current Price Sheet




Criteria Tab:

- Phones: Link only the phones that list at the denomination in the promotion (i.e. \$219.99).
- Terms: Select *only* the newly created Financing terms here.
- Rate Plan: Leave at default of All.



California Dealers ONLY Additional Steps:


A few extra steps are required to deal with the California taxes. Create a promotion for each of the Adjustment NSPs created previously. The Details and Criteria tab setup steps will be the same as the promotion setup steps above with one exception: The Quantity for each Adjustment promotion will be -1. This will subtract the California tax amount from the transaction.




Sales Flow

After the setup is complete, use the following steps to sell a Financed device:

a. Complete a sale as usual while selecting one of the Financing terms in the Phone Activation Wizard (PAW).



- b. The One Up Billing Promotion NSP will be automatically added to the invoice screen, with a prompt to enter the customer phone number Enter the phone number and click **OK**.
- c. The phone tax will be added to the invoice based on the phone list price represented by the Promotion NSP (see example below). Complete the transaction as usual. Accessories and Features can be added at any time.



Tax Reporting

Sales by Invoice Report with Filter: Click on the Filter button at the top of the screen to display column filters. Use >0 to filter out only the financed transactions and refer to the tax column total for an accurate summary of your financed devices tax.

Sales by Invoice Report with Grouping: Drag the Financing Payment Method column header into the Grouping box to determine your financed devices tax totals.
