



WIND Carrier Integration Enhancements as of 4.11

WindMobile and iQmetrix have been working to enhance the user experience. As of 4.11 additional improvements have been made to the integration including:

A. Enhanced SOC Code Library

The following Rate plans can be mapped to the SOC Code sheet for one to one mapping. Due to the expanded functionality, you no longer need to have a rate plan for all upgrades. Your terms and Rate Plans can be broken out below (you may require additional terms for your own reporting needs):

B. Account Number fills Contract Field

The Account number is automatically populated in the Contract Field of the PAW and is stored. When using the Carrier integration, you will no longer see the Contract field as it will be automatically filled behind the scenes.

C. SIM Only activations through the Import

You can now use SIM only activations through the PAW. Simply enter the ICCID of the Activated SIM Card and it will bring the activation details of that SIM Card. Note: entering the ICCID of a SIM Card sold with a device will prompt an error. If a device is activated, you must search the IMEI of that device.
